Students Taking First Year Course Within 12 Credits

- The percent of students taking a first-year course in their first 12 credits increased for BUSL 101 (+1 point) and FYE 101 (+8 points), but not for AH 101 (-3).
- For the most recent year, students enrolling in the course within their first 12 credits was less than 30% for each course.

- In almost all instances, the fall-to-spring persistence rate was higher for students in a first-year course than the College FTIC average. The one exception was BUSL 101 for the Fall 2019 cohort.
- Changes for AH 101 (-3 points) and FYE 101 (-<1 point) were similar to that of the College (-1 point).
- The fall-to-spring persistence rate decreased by -5 points for BUSL 101.

VI. 200% GRADUATION RATE

* For the Fall 2018 cohort, 200% will be completed after August 2022.

** For the Fall 2019 cohort, 200% will be completed after August 2023.

- AH 101 and FYE 101 had finalized data for the first two cohorts. The 200% graduation rate increased for both AH 101 (+2 points) and FYE 101 (+3 points). In comparison, it decreased by 2 points for the College overall.
- The 200% graduation rate for the Fall 2017 cohort ranged from 24% for BUSL 101 to 29% for FYE 101. It was 13% for the College cohort.
- Preliminary data shows that students enrolled in the first-year courses have higher 200% graduation rates than the College cohorts.
