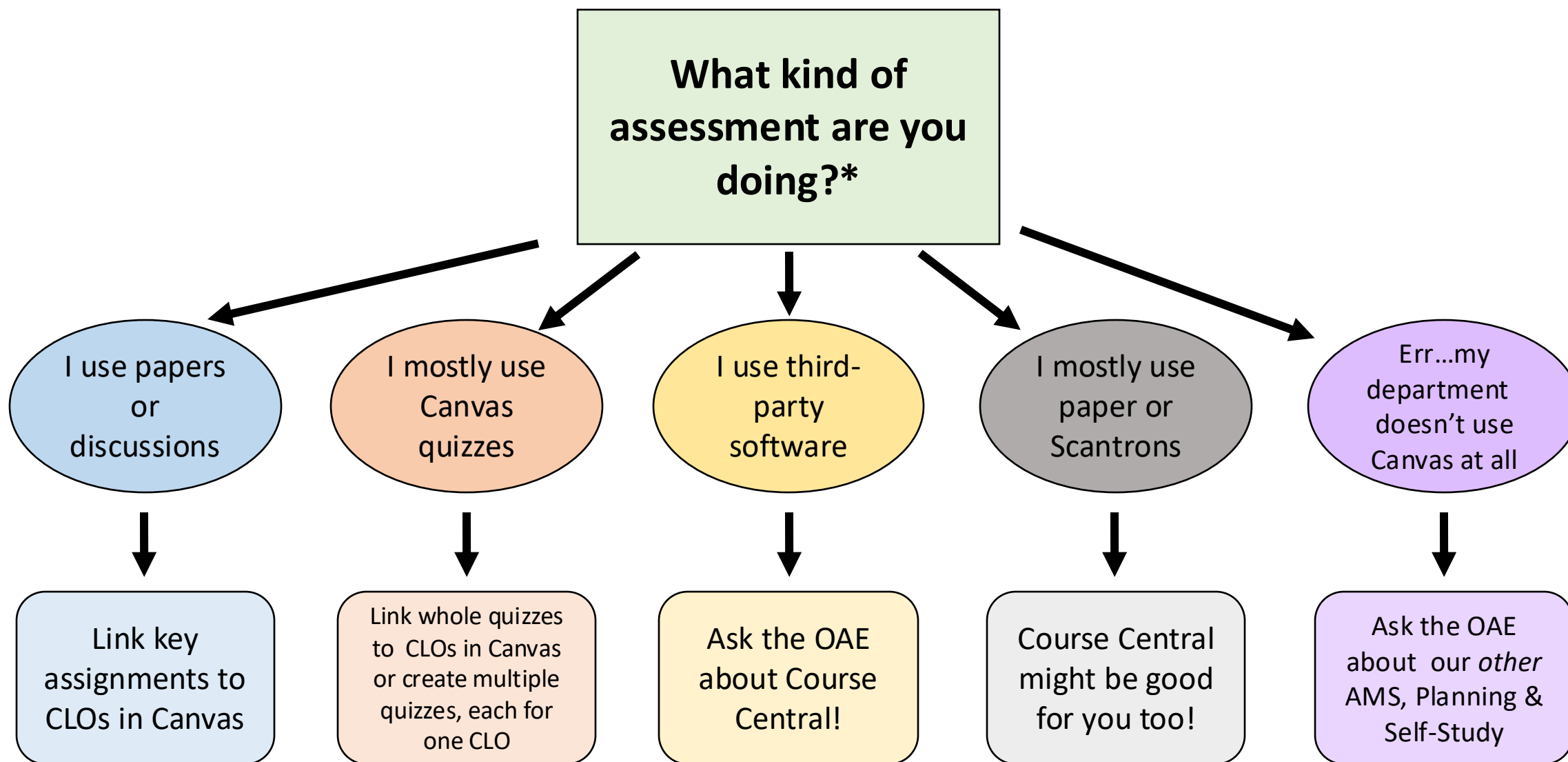

RISE FROM WITHIN



*More than one can apply to you.



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Are you going to copy your course from a previous semester?

- Course copying saves time but results in **multiple copies** of CLOs.
- **Delete** the extra CLOs after you copy your course.
- **Each CLO** should be linked to **at least one key assignment** for assessment.

RISE FROM WITHIN



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If your assignments from a previous semester are already linked, they should still be linked!

New Quizzes in Canvas are an exception to this. We'll get to that shortly...



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Once you've linked, assess as you go!

For assignments linked to CLOs using rubrics (pretty much everything but quizzes), use **SpeedGrader** to assess student work on those assignments as you go.

Linking alone will not yield any data.



RISE FROM WITHIN



You might have general education outcomes!

If you see something in your outcomes list that starts with one of these:

- SCRE
- OCCE
- TEC
- CAI
- WRI
- QURE

Those are **general education outcomes**, and you don't have to worry about them if you haven't been notified that you're part of gen ed assessment in the current semester.



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CLO Assessment Rubric Scales Go from 4 to 0

4 = Exemplary

3 = Proficient

2 = Approaching Proficiency

1 = Needs Improvement

0 = No Evidence Available

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Gen Ed Rubrics Go from 3 to 0 or from 2 to 0

Most gen ed rubric scales :

2 = Proficient

1 = Not Proficient

0 = Did Not Submit

0 = Not Applicable

CAI rubric scales:

3 = Proficient

2 = Nearing Proficiency

1 = Not Proficient

0 = Did Not Submit

0 = Not Applicable

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Using new quizzes? Don't panic!

If you have already linked CLOs to the **total score** on a New Quiz, when you copy that course for the next semester, the Quiz won't show up in your alignments tab, but it **IS** still linked to that Outcome.





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Using new quizzes? Don't panic! (continued)

As long as there are **no changes to that Outcome** (i.e., course revision), we will continue to receive your data for Insights.

If you want data summaries to continue appearing in your Learning Mastery Gradebook, **Outcomes will need to be re-linked** for New Quizzes.
