## **Overview of Project**

Through bi-monthly activities, the Career Services Center and The Office of Alumni Relations will collaborate to connect employers, alumni, faculty, and students, both at the main campus and at regional centers, to provide students with career planning and employment development strategies. The Speakers Series will pay particular attention to helping students to understand the often "unspoken and unwritten rules" for workplace success.

The benefits of the program are twofold impacting both the student and the alumni participant. The Alumni Speakers Series will enhance the services provided by the new Career Service Center in the area of career advising and it will also be an opportunity for alumni to deepen their ties to the College.

Each bi-monthly event will differ in time, theme and possibly location to allow students and participants of varying schedules and interests to attend.

Goal - To hold 6 Alumni Speakers Series events before June 2004 with an attendance of at least 20 students at each event.
