## **Academic Honesty**

Bettsy distributed a handout titled "Academic Honesty Definitions," a draft for discussion, listing some specific violations of academic honesty policy, including plagiarism, cheating in class, cheating outside the classroom, electronic cheating, fabrication, and some other examples of academic misconduct.

In addition, a document (draft May 25, 2009) "procedures for Handling and Reporting Academic Dishonesty" and "Appeals Procedure" was also distributed.

Bettsy suggested these draft documents were to be considered when discussing Policy revisions within the committee and with members of the College community, who will be sought out for feedback.

The issue of when and if faculty should meet privately with students before reporting a violation of Policy in writing to the department head was raised again, and differing opinions were heard.
