This is to inform you that I have taken the following actions on recommendations

Approved the Proposal to change the College technological competency requirement and the related revision of CIS 103.

The change to the technological competency requirement includes three specific recommendations accompanied by a set of goals and objectives. The three recommendations included in my approval are as follows:

- •The list of technological competency goals and objectives will serve as the College's definition of technological competency.
- •Students may satisfy the new technological competency requirement through successful completion of 1) any course which includes all of the goals and objectives in the College's definition of technological competency; or 2) any set of courses which collectively include all of the goals and objectives in the College's definition of technological competency.
- •CIS 103 has been revised to include all of the goals and objectives in the College's definition of technological competency and will serve as the primary course satisfying the new technological competency requirement.

The new technological competency requirement will go into effect for the Fall 2010 term.
