Institution-Wide Committee Decisions

The following Institution-Wide Committee actions have been approved:

- Approved the revisions to Memorandum 156: Minors on Campus effective upon Board of Trustees approval.
 The word occasional was added to the memo title.
- Approved the A.A.S. in Web and Mobile Application Development program revision, reducing credit hours to 65 from 63. Program learning outcomes will remain the same.
- Approved the A.S. in Chemistry program revision increasing credit hours from 60 to 67.
- Approved the A.A.S. in Nursing program revision increasing credit hours from 64 to 69 to accommodate additional NCLEX preparation and coursework in health assessment.
- Approved the A.A.S. in Surgical Technology new program proposal for the 2026-2027 academic year, establishing a new program in the Division of Math, Science, and Health Careers.
- Approved the A.A.S. in Behavioral Health/Human Services program revision, responding to a request from the Board of Trustees Student Outcomes Committee. The revision includes a new practicum and brings addiction recovery coursework into alignment with state and local standards.
- Approved the A.A.S in Electrical Engineering Technology new program for the 2025-2026 academic year, establishing a new program in the Division of Math, Science, and Health Careers.
- Approved the Cybersecurity A.A.S. program revision with the following changes:
 - Approved the program name change from Cybersecurity to Cybersecurity and Networking;
 - o Approved the adding of a new course, CIS 256 Network Routing and Switching, to the program;
 - Approved the replacement of FNMT 118 Intermediate Algebra or higher math with Math 121 Computer Mathematics and Logic or Math 150 Introductory Data Analysis; and
 - Approved the increase of the total credits for the Cybersecurity and Networking A.A.S. program from 60 to 62.
