SUBJECT: Institution-Wide Committee Decisions

I have received the minutes of the March 23, 2026 and April 27, 2026 Institution-Wide Committee meetings, and have taken the following actions:

1. Approved Dr. Lisa Sanders as its new chair.
2. Approved updates to the Posting Policy.
 - a. Under the new policy, the Office of Facilities will remove all postings from all boards within 60 days. Questions about whether postings comply with College policies (including those related to credit card solicitation) should be directed to facilities@ccp.edu. The Office of Facilities will work directly with the General Counsel's Office on next steps.
3. Approved a new program, Fire Emergency Services (A.A.S.).
 - a. The Fire and Emergency Services program is a comprehensive foundational and career development curriculum designed to provide students with a thorough understanding of the core concepts and methods used in emergency management and response.
4. Approved a new program, Social Research and Analysis (A.A.).
 - a. The Social Research and Analysis (SRA) program is an interdisciplinary Associate of Arts degree that prepares students for academic transfer and workforce entry in research-related fields.
5. Approved updates to Memorandum #10: Academic and Time Amnesty.
 - a. Under the updated policy, the Provost and Vice President of Academic and Student Success may appoint a designee to grant academic or time amnesty to a student.
6. Approved updates to Memorandum #151: Smoke-Free Campus Policy.
 - a. The revisions add marijuana, vaping, and e-cigarettes to the list of prohibited forms of smoking on campus.

7. Approved to delay a vote on the proposed A.A.S. in Law and Paralegal Studies until the College's Federal Student Aid Program Participation Agreement (PPA) is recertified so students can apply financial aid to the program.
8. Approved to delay a vote on granting student parents access to early registration pending additional research by the General Counsel's Office.
